
Woven | Viridian and Amber

Making the Block Strip Sets

From each amber print, cut:

10 strips, 1" x 42"

 $6 \text{ strips}, 2" \times 42"$


From light print, cut:

9 strips, 1" x 42"

3 strip, 2" x 42"


Cut the selvedges off each strip, cut in half and then half again to yield 4 strips approximately $10^{1/2}$ " long. Save extra strips for future strip sets.

Note: These are the same strip sets as previous block. If you have extra use them up first.




Make 7 strip sets measuring $6" \times 10^{1/2}" Subcut the following units;$

24 strips, 1" x 6"



Make 6 strip sets measuring 6" x $10^{1/2}$ " Subcut the following units; $48 \, \text{strips}, 1$ " x 6"



Make 24 blocks 6" x 6"

Assembling the Blocks

From light print, cut:

2 strips, 6 " x 42 " subcut; 24 rectangles, $2^{1/2}$ " x 6 " 1 strip, 6 " x 42 " subcut; 24 rectangles, $1^{1/2}$ " x 6 "

1. Use the strip set units to piece 24 blocks, measuring 6" square including seam allowances.
