## Making the Block StripSets

From each amber print, cut:
10 strips, 1 " $\times 42$ "
6 strips, 2" x 42"

From lisht print, cut:
9 strips, 1" $\times 42$
3 strip, $2 " \times 42 "$

Cut the selvedges off each strip, cut in half and then half again to yield 4 strips approximately $10^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}}$ long. Save extra strips for future strip sets.

Note: These are the same strip sets as previous block. It you have extra use them up first.


Make 7 strip sets measurin 86 " $\times 10^{1 / 2 " S u b c u t ~ t h e ~ f o l l o w i n ~} \delta$ units; 24 strips, $1^{1 / 2 "} \times{ }^{\prime \prime}$
24 strips, 1 " $\times 6$ "


Make 6 strip sets measurin $86^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1 / 2 "}$ Subcut the followin 8 units; 48 strips, 1 " $\times 0$ "
