
## Box of Chocolates

Finished Quilt  $8" \times 10"$  | Finished Block  $1^{1/2}"$ 



## Culling:

for each block cut  $1|1^{1/4}$ " square and  $1|1^{1/4}$ " x 2" rectangle from red print and  $1|1^{1/4}$ " square from light print from setting fabric cut 4|2" squares (cut 2 squares once diagonally | corners)

 $2 \mid 3^{1/2}$ " squares { cut twice diagonally | setting triangles }

for side borders cut  $2 \mid 2$ " strips { use your quilt center dimensions for length } for top and bottom borders cut  $2 \mid 2$ " strips { use your quilt center dimensions for length } from binding fabric cut  $1 \mid 1^{1/2}$ " x width of fabric strip | single thickness binding

## Assemble:

- 1. Make 6 chocolate heart blocks as follows:
- 2. Layout and piece quilt center using diagram.
- 3. Add side borders using your quilt center measurements for length of strips.
- 4. Add top and bottom border using your quilts measurements for length of strips.
- 5. Quilt as desired. This is the perfect opportunity to practice a little hand quilting. Visit our blog, look on the sidebar for a tutorial on how we finish a small quilt.
- 6. Bind using single thickness binding.
