- 1. Use the simple cutting directions below to cut the necessary strips.
- 2. Layout the guilt top on your worksurface and carefully stitch the strips together with a scant 1/4" seam allowance. Finger press towards the dark and iron lightly.
- 3. Use the cross stitch alphabet to personalize your Grainsack Quilt. Mark the simple X placement using your favorite removable marking tool. With embroidery floss stitch the X's.
- 4. Hand or machine guilt with a few simple vertical lines. Bind using single thickness binding.
