Finished Quilt ~ 28" x 32"

Fabric Requirements

16 different print scraps at least 6" x 9"

1/8 yard cheddar solid

1/4 yard red solid

3/8 yard tan solid

3/4 yard light solid

Cutting

Use diagram below to cut 16 house blocks from prints/solid

From light solid cut:

 $20 \, \text{rectangles}, 2^{1/2} \, \text{x} \, 5$

8 strips, 1" x 28 1/2"


From tan solid cut:

 $5 \, \text{strips}, 2^{1/2}$ " x $28^{1/2}$ "

From red solid cut:


32 squares, 1" x 1" - chimneys

 $3\,\mathrm{strips}\,1^{1/2}$'s width of fabric – binding



Making the Blocks

- 1. Use diagram below to make 16 house blocks.
- 2. Cut house pieces using measurement on diagram. **Measurements include seam al- lowance.**
- Create roof section, using your favorite template material, add seam allowance to template pieces.
- 4. House blocks should measure 5" square including seam allowances.





Quilt Assembly

- 1. Using House blocks and $2^{1/2}$ 'x 5" sashing strips, make four rows of four house blocks.
- 2. Add a 1" \times 28 $^{1/2}$ " border strip to top and bottom of each row.
- 3. Use $2^{1/2}$ " x $28^{1/2}$ " tan border strips to join rows together.
- 4. Add applique motifs using your favorite technique and motifs on page 3.
- 5. Quilt as desired and bind using single thickness binding.
