Fabric Requirements

Large variety of light, medium and dark scraps $1^{1/4}$ yard brown stripe 1/2 yard red print | binding $1^{1/2}$ yard | backing

Cutting for one block | Cut 120 blocks


From a variety of light, medium and dark prints, cut: 4 squares, 2 " x 2 " | 120 sets total $2 \text{ strip}, 1^{1/4} \text{ " x } 2 \text{ " } | 120 \text{ pairs total}$ $1 \text{ strip}, 1^{1/4} \text{ " x } 4^{1/4} \text{ " } | 120 \text{ total}$

From brown stripe, cut: 2 strips, $4^{1/4}$ " x 38"


From red print, cut: 5 strips, $2^{1/4}$ " x 42"

Making the blocks | Make 120 blocks

1. Lay out 2" squares and $1^{1/4}$ " strips in three rows. Sew the pieces together in rows. Join the rows to make a block measuring $4^{1/4}$ " square, including seam allowances. *Please note pressing arrows*.



Press 60 blocks in direction of arrows



Press 60 blocks in direction of arrows

Assembling the quilt

- 1. Lay out guilt top in twelve rows of ten blocks, alternating blocks to nest together seam allowances.
- 2. Join the rows alternating seams at intersections.
- 3. Add top and bottom borders to guilt center.
- 4. Quilt as desired and bind.
