
Plum Pudding Patchwork

Finished Quilt 35" x 44 1/2" | Finished Block 3 1/2"



Fabric Requirements

1/4 yard bundle Needlework Necessities. $1^{1/4}$ yard lavender print 1/2 yard red stripe | binding $1^{1/2}$ yard | backing

Cutting

From each of 20 Needlework Necessities print, cut: 1 strip, 3" x 42" subcut:

 $8 \, \text{squares}, 3 \, \text{``x} \, 3 \, \text{``cut diagonally once} \\ 8 \, \text{squares}, 1^{3/4} \, \text{``x} \, 1^{3/4} \, \text{``}$

 $1\,\mathrm{strip}, 1^{1/8}\mbox{"} \ge 42\mbox{"}$ subcut: $7\,\mathrm{strips}, 1^{1/8}\mbox{"} \ge 6\mbox{"}$

Note | I added a few other brown prints from my stash to give my quilt an even scrappier look. Cut accordingly. Also I did not cut 3" squares from the two lavender prints.

From lavender print, cut:

3 strips, $4" \times 42"$ subcut: 54 strips, $1^{3/4}" \times 4"$ 10 strips, $1^{3/4}" \times 42"$ subcut: 10 strips, $1^{3/4}" \times 32^{1/2}"$ 3 strips, $1^{3/4}" \times 42"$ Piece 2 strips, $1^{3/4}" \times 44^{1/2}"$

From red stripe, cut: 5 strips, $2^{1/4}$ " x 42"

Making the blocks | Make 63 blocks

1. Pair up $1^{1/8}$ " x 6" strips into 63 sets. Stitch strips together on long edge. Press seam and cut into four $1^{1/8}$ " segments. Using the segments make 2 Four Patch blocks measuring $1^{3/4}$ " square, including seam allowances.

 $2. Using two 1^{3/4}" squares piece a double Four Patch block measuring 3" square, including seam allowances.\\$

3. Add four triangles to each side of Double Four Patch block. Trim block to measure 4" square, including seam allowances.











Assembling the guilt

- 1. Lay out guilt top in nine rows of seven blocks with six sashing strips separating blocks. Sew rows together.
- 2. Join rows separating each row with a $1^{3/4}$ " x $32^{1/2}$ " sashing strip. Add sashing strip to the top and bottom.
- 3. Finish guilt top by adding a $1^{3/4}$ " x $44^{1/2}$ " sashing strips to each side of guilt.
- 4. Quilt as desired and bind using red stripe $2^{1/4}$ " strips.
