

# Plum Pudding Patchwork

Finished Quilt 35" x 44<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" | Finished Block 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"



## Fabric Requirements

1/4 yard bundle Needlework Necessities.

1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> yard lavender print

1/2 yard red stripe | binding

1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> yard | backing

## Cutting

From each of 20 Needlework Necessities print, cut:

1 strip, 3" x 42" subcut:

8 squares, 3" x 3" cut diagonally once

8 squares, 1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>"

1 strip, 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 42" subcut: 7 strips, 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 6"

*Note / I added a few other brown prints from my stash to give my quilt an even scrappier look. Cut accordingly. Also I did not cut 3" squares from the two lavender prints.*

From lavender print, cut:

3 strips, 4" x 42" subcut: 54 strips, 1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 4"

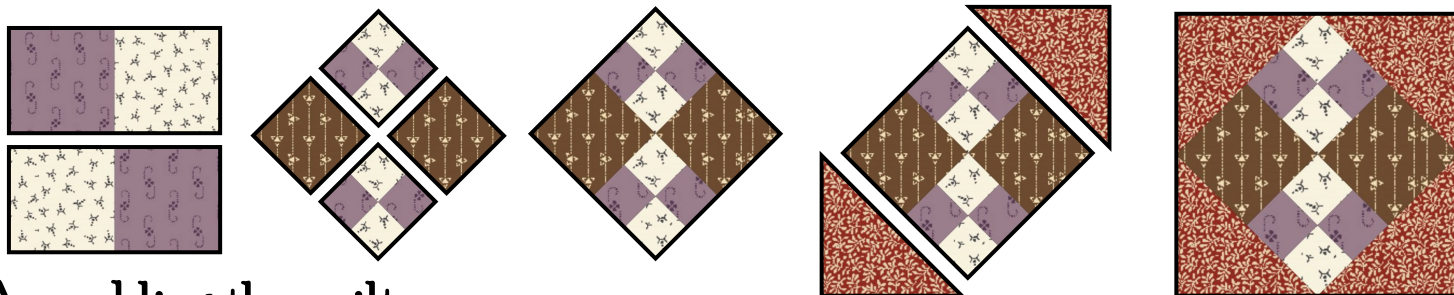
10 strips, 1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 42" subcut: 10 strips, 1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 32<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"

3 strips 1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 42" Piece 2 strips, 1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 44<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"

From red stripe, cut: 5 strips, 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 42"

## Making the blocks | Make 63 blocks

1. Pair up 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 6" strips into 63 sets. Stitch strips together on long edge. Press seam and cut into four 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" segments. Using the segments make 2 Four Patch blocks measuring 1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" square, including seam allowances.
2. Using two 1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" squares piece a double Four Patch block measuring 3" square, including seam allowances.
3. Add four triangles to each side of Double Four Patch block. Trim block to measure 4" square, including seam allowances.



## Assembling the quilt

1. Lay out quilt top in nine rows of seven blocks with six sashing strips separating blocks. Sew rows together.
2. Join rows separating each row with a 1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 32<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" sashing strip. Add sashing strip to the top and bottom.
3. Finish quilt top by adding a 1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 44<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" sashing strips to each side of quilt.
4. Quilt as desired and bind using red stripe 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" strips.
