Sweet Valentine

Finished Size $4^{5/8}$ " x $6^{3/4}$ "







Cutting:

From dark print, cut: 2 squares, 1" \times 1" and 2 rectangles, 1" \times 1^{1/2}"

From light print, cut: 2 squares, 1" x 1"

 $2\,\mathrm{squares}, 2^{\,3/4}\mathrm{''}\,\mathrm{x}\,2^{\,3/4}\mathrm{''}$, cut twice diagonally to yield $8\,\mathrm{triangles}.$

For border, cut: 1 strip, 1 3/8" x 13"

For binding, cut: 1 strip, 1 1/2" x 42"

Making the Block

1. Make two Heart blocks as diagramed.







Assembling the Quilt

- 1. Layout and piece guilt center using Heart blocks, light triangles and valentine diagrams.
- 2. Trim guilt center to $2^{1/8}$ " x $3^{5/8}$ ". Be sure to leave 1/4" beyond block corners.
- 3. Add side borders using your quilts measurements for length of strips.
- 4. Add top and bottom border using your quilts measurements for length of strips.
- 5. Quilt as desired. This is the perfect opportunity to practice a little hand guilting.
- 6. Bind using single thickness binging.

I purchased envelopes at the craft store measuring $4^{1/2}x5^{3/4}$ "
They are perfect if you want to mail a Sweet Valentine to a special friend.
