Fabric Requirements

A variety of red print scraps 1/6 yard red print 1/4 yard light print

Cutting

From a variety of red prints, cut:

18 squares, 1" x 1" 18 rectangles, 1" x 1 ^{1/2}" 17 squares, 2" x 2"

From light print, cut:


3 strips 2" x 42"; subcut 4 strips 2" x 12" 34 squares, 2" x 2", cut once diagonally 18 squares, 1" x 1" 2 strips, 2" x 42 subcut; 4 strips 2" x 12"


From red polka-dot, cut:


1 strip, 1" x 42" subcut; 2 strips 1" x 11" and 2 strips 1" x 9" 2 strips, $1^{1/2}$ " x 42" | binding

Making the Blocks

- 1. Join one 1" light and red square. Add a 1" $\times 1^{1/2}$ " rectangle to each unit.
- 2. Add a light triangle to opposite sides of each block. Press out and add two additional triangles to remaining sides. Trim blocks to 2" square, including seam allowances.







- 3. Layout quilt center as diagramed above.
- 4. Add 1" x 11" red side inner borders, add 1" x 9" red top and bottom inner borders.
- $5. Add 2" \times 12"$ light side borders, add remaining light border strips to top and bottom of guilt center.
- 6. Quilt as desired. I hand guilted mine with a simple diagonally cross hatch through the solid
