


# Vintage Valentine

Finished Quilt  $13\frac{1}{2}'' \times 16''$

Finished Block  $2\frac{1}{4}'' \times 2\frac{1}{4}''$



## Cutting

From light print, cut:

10 squares,  $3\frac{3}{4}'' \times 3\frac{3}{4}''$

6 squares,  $2\frac{3}{4}'' \times 2\frac{3}{4}''$

2 strips,  $2'' \times 14''$  and  $2\frac{3}{4}'' \times 16\frac{1}{2}''$

From pink print for binding, cut:

2 strips,  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times$  width of fabric

From a variety of red and pink prints, cut:

10 squares,  $3\frac{3}{4}'' \times 3\frac{3}{4}''$

## Making the Blocks

1. Pair the  $3\frac{3}{4}''$  squares; draw a diagonal line on wrong side of the light square from each pair. Sew  $1\frac{1}{4}''$  from both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the line to yield two half-square-triangle units. Trim ten of the units to  $2\frac{3}{4}''$  square, including seam allowances. Trim the remaining units to  $1\frac{5}{8}''$  square, including seam allowances. Use the smaller half-square-triangle units to make some of the 20 blocks.

## Assembling the Quilt Top

1. Using the diagram lay out the blocks, half-square-triangles and squares in six rows. Sew the blocks together in rows. Join the rows matching seam intersections.

2. Add  $2'' \times 14''$  strips to each side of quilt center and  $2\frac{3}{4}'' \times 16\frac{1}{2}''$  strips to top and bottom of quilt center.

## Finishing the Quilt

Quilt as desired and bind using single thickness binding.

Fabric Requirements:  
A variety of red and pink scraps | blocks  
 $1\frac{1}{4}$  yard light print | background  
 $1\frac{1}{8}$  yard pink print | binding  
Fat Quarter | backing
